## **OPERATOR'S REPORT – DUSTY KELLER**

- 1. The plant is running very well. No mechanical or process problems to report
- 2. Brent McFeaters and I met with the engineers that are working on the proposed radio tower that would be located inside the fence at the wastewater treatment plant.
- 3. We continue to work with the engineer in the planning phase of the plant upgrade. (*no change*)
- 4. I placed an order for replacement weat plates and impellors for the pumps at the Ingram Micro pumpstation. The cost for the parts was \$2,665.56. I spoke with the Township Manager before placing the order. When the parts arrive, my staff and I will carry out the installation (*no change, waiting for parts.*)
- 5. For the month of March, the average daily flow through the plant was 79,600 gallons for a total monthly flow of 2.47 million gallons. There was 3.00" of rainfall recorded during the month.

- **3.** Cellular Tower at WWTP: We have been consulting with the Township Manager during the month regarding a location on the WWTP property for the proposed tower.
- 4. Industrial Waste Discharge Program: We reviewed the most recent sampling results from dischargers provided to us by FSWA. We are working with FSWA to notify users of the results. Although several of the users exceeded ammonia nitrogen limits, which historically is common, there was nothing that created any significant concerns.
