The Union Township Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Wednesday, October 11, 2023. The meeting was held at the Municipal Building, 3111 State Route 72, Jonestown, PA.

Approve the Lickdale Sewer Meeting Minutes for September 12, 2023, a motion was made by Dennis Firestone and seconded by Gary Longenecker. All Approved.

Approve the Financial Report for September 2023, a motion was made by Kerry McCrary and seconded by Gary Longenecker. All Approved.

Operator's Report – Dusty Keller reported that the plant is running well. Dusty stated that 3 of the 4 online dissolved oxygen probes are starting to drift and they should be replaced. The cost for one probe is approximately \$350, and the total cost for four new probes is \$1,413.57. The motion was made to purchase the probes by Dennis Firestone and seconded by Kerry McCrary. All Approved. For the month of September, the average daily flows were 94,000 gallons and the total monthly flows were 2.82 million gallons. There was 6.60" of rainfall recorded during the month. No flow issues, flows are leveling out, issues were found that the user usages were up over the past few months.

Engineer's Report – Scott Rights reported that there was no additional information as to what was covered in Dusty's report. There are no new projects on the books and Scott Rights mentioned that he had discussed with Brent McFeaters a budget number for the sewer lines to be televised for the 2024 Budget.

Attorney's Report - Paul Bametzreider reported that he has no new information for this month.

New Business - there was none to report.

Old Business - there was none to report.

Bills payable – Sewer Fund in the amount of \$160,451.02, a motion was made by Dennis Firestone and seconded by Gary Longenecker. All Approved.
